Program Overview:

The Craig Kielburger Business Program exposes students to many aspects of business while customizing their high school experience to suit their interests and talents. It offers an opportunity to help prepare for a successful post secondary transition to Apprenticeship training, College, University, or Employment, while meeting the requirements of the Ontario Secondary School Diploma (OSSD).

Students have opportunities to explore a wide variety of different aspects of business such as Marketing, Accounting, Entrepreneurship and International Business. It also allows for experimental learning through unique experiences such as running various aspects of the school store and even the prospect of taking hands-on business courses at Walt Disney World in Orlando, Florida.

Students will development leadership, management, teamwork and problem solving skills with this unique experience. Ultimately, students will attain the credits, skills, and knowledge that is critical in the field of Business and help them make informed decisions about their direction after High School. The SHSM Program helps students better prepare for life in a changing world.

Students must select a combination of 4 business courses during their Grade 11 and Grade 12 year from a wide variety of areas such as:

- Accounting
- Entrepreneurship
- International Business
- Marketing
- Management & Leadership
- Information & Communications Technology
- Economics
- Law



Course Package:

The Business SHSM program allows student to discover the important connection between school experiences, business and all post-secondary pursuits. Students learn practical and transferable life and work skills that help them to embark on their career choice with confidence.

The Program Consists of:

- 4 Business Credits in Grade 11 and Grade 12
- 1-2 English Credits (depending on pathway), including a unit related to Business
- 1-2 Math Credits (depending on pathway), including a unit related to Business
- 2 credits of Cooperative Education completed in Grade 11 or 12 or through the Summer Internship Program
- 6 or more employer recognized certification and training courses covering areas many employers demand, such as Standard First Aid, CPR, WHMIS, Leadership, Conflict Resolution and Customer Service
- Development of problem solving, teamwork, management and leadership skills in a business setting
