Why consider Concentrated OYAP in Auto Body?

- **Auto Body Concentrated OYAP** is specifically designed to help secondary school students make a smooth transition directly into the post-secondary apprenticeship program. Students will learn about Auto Body and/or Automotive Painting
- This program takes 2 semesters to complete. In semester 1, you will take 2 grade 11 auto body credits plus 2 other credits and in semester 2 you will take 2 grade 12 auto body credits plus 2 credits coop in an auto body shop
- Similar courses are offered at both colleges and private vocational training facilities. Why not start the program now before you leave high school?

In the Auto Body OYAP program, students;

- Shorten their apprenticeship by receiving apprenticeship hours while being registered as an OYAP apprentice in cooperative education
- Receive Standard First Aid, Adult CPR, Young Worker awareness and WHMIS training
- Get their foot in the door with a potential employer
- May save thousands of dollars on similar courses offered at colleges and private vocational training centres
- This program can also be done as a Specialist High Skills Major, which would start in grade 11

This program can lead you to become: Auto body tech, automotive painter, estimator, or motor vehicle manufacturer.

Income from \$11-\$25+ per hour

Apprenticeship

- Earn \$\$ while you learn
- A combination of on-the-job training and College courses
- Will be taught one on one by a Licensed Skilled tradesperson
- An apprenticeship contract is an agreement between an employer, employee and the Ministry of Training, Colleges & Universities
