



Chef/Baker OYAP

Why consider Concentrated OYAP in Chef/Baker?

- **Chef/Baker Concentrated OYAP** is specifically designed to help secondary school students make a smooth transition directly into a career to complete their Apprenticeship
- Offers the curriculum for level 1 apprenticeship training for Cook as well as the Ontario Ministry of Education curriculum
- This program can also be done as a Specialist High Skills Major, which would start in grade 11
- May jump start their career by being registered as an OYAP apprentice while in Cooperative Education. This may shorten their apprenticeship by receiving apprenticeship hours
- May receive their Food Handlers Certificate, Standard First Aid, Adult CPR, Young Worker Awareness and WHMIS certification

How does this program work?

This program consists of 2 grade 11 and 2 grade 12 hospitality credits and a minimum of 2 Cooperative Education credits. This program is available at Robert Bateman High School in Burlington. It is recommended that the student begin the concentrated OYAP in grade 12.



Opportunities in Chef/Baker OYAP

You could find a very rewarding career as a cook, assistant cook, baker, patissier, retail meat cutter, restaurant manager.

Salary

Varies greatly. You can make between \$30,000 to \$70,000 per year (more if you are a restaurant owner).

Apprenticeship

- Earn \$\$ while you learn
- A combination of on-the-job training and College courses
- Will be taught one on one by a Skilled tradesperson
- An apprenticeship contract is an agreement between an employer, employee and the Ministry of Training, Colleges & Universities
